

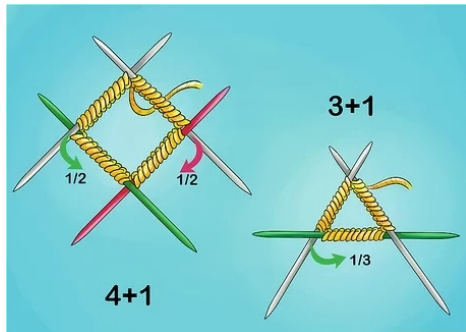

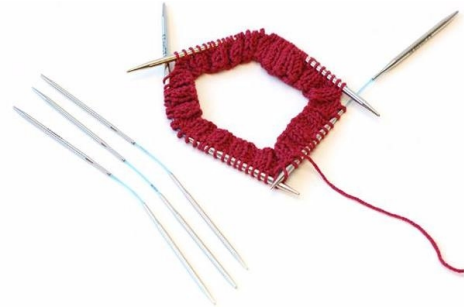
Small Circumference Knitting

- 2 Circulars
- 1 LONG Circular (Magic Loop)

Double Points-FlexFlips



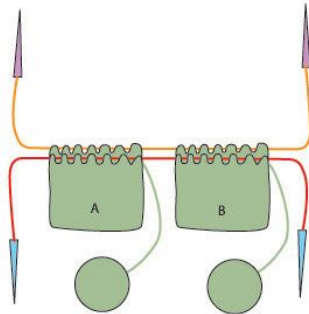

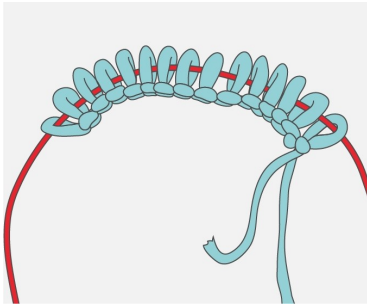

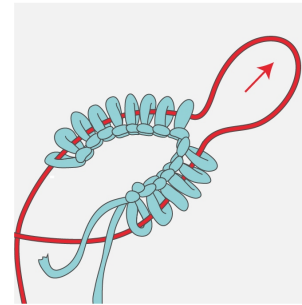
Magic Loop - 1

Using a 32" or longer circular, CO stitches. Move sts to cable.



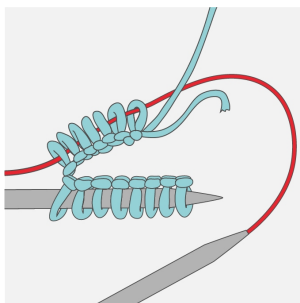
Magic Loop 2 - Pull Out a Loop

Pull out a loop about 6" long. Try to keep sts from twisting.



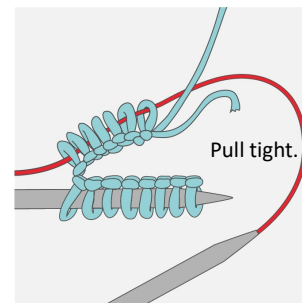
Magic Loop 3 – Orient Stitches

Position "first CO sts" at tip of needle and remainder on cable.



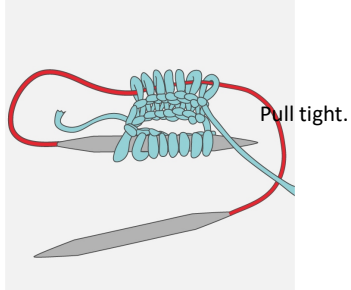
Magic Loop 4 – Begin Knitting

Insert Needle tip in first st and begin knitting.
Work to end of stitches on first needle.



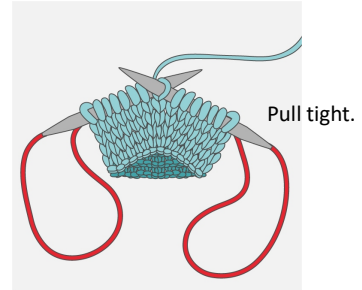
Magic Loop 5 – Second Needle

Push sts on to second needle tip.
Work to end of stitches on second needle.



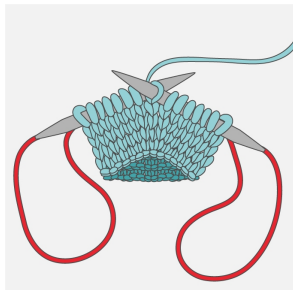
Magic Loop – Repeat Steps 4 & 5

Work along Needle 1, then work along Needle 2.
Don't pull too tight at "corners".
