- 1. Cocoknits Sweater Workshop Book (explains the Cocoknit Method in words and pictures.)
 - Available at Nautical Yarn
- 2. Colorful Stitch Markers (yellow, violet, blue, orange, green, red)
- 3. Stitch Holder Kit (or scrap yarn to hold stitches)
- 4. Knitting Row Counter (optional)
- 5. Heavy worsted / Aran weight yarn.

Sizes S (M, L, 1X, 2X, 3X)

Approximately 1075 (1275, 1450, 1650, 1850, 2050) yds.

Needles:

US 10 (or size needed to obtain gauge) circular needle 40"

US 4 needles for working BO

US 0-3 double-pointed needle or any length circular needle (for picking up stitches)

At Nautical Yarn, we will be a step or two ahead of you, but knitting right along with the KAL. Let's do this together.

Debbie & Michele — Debbie and Michele have been busy knitting up a storm for Christmas. I won't be specific, but friends and family members are going to be very happy this year when they see their colorful, expertly knit (and crocheted) gifts.

- I knit my 10 year old granddaughter some very pretty mittens using an adaptation of Love Still Wins from Ravelry.
- For myself, I knit the Tallulah Vest from Cocoknits using the yarn Extra from Blue Sky Fibers.
- I knit a double knit headband using Rowan's new cashmere yarn. So, so soft.
- I am working on an original design Aran cardigan sweater using Shepherd's Wool. The sweater consists of vertical panels of 2 x 2 rib, double moss stitch, heart shaped and four-leaf clover cables with a "horizontal" cable design at the yoke. It has been a lot of fun and a challenge to design and knit. (no pictures at this time)
- Some of the most fun I have had recently is rug hooking. I learned latch hook rug hooking when I was a kid, but I am learning rug hooking using a traditional rug hook and a punch needle rug hook. I agreed to repair a customer's brand new Christmas pillow that her puppy had snagged and pulled the loops out of. I realized rug hooking was a great way to use up dribs and drabs of yarn of any weight, color, or fiber (although wool is best). This led to the upcoming **Rug Hooking Class** scheduled for February 2021. Give it a try. I think you will like it. I'm kind of obsessed.
- I knit some hats and cowls for Christmas gifts and have completed, wrapped and mailed the sweaters for two sons. Bob's **LEE** sweater designed by Martin Storey is wrapped up under our tiny fiber optic tree. He has seen it as I worked on it and on display in the shop, but is totally unaware that it is a man's sweater or that it is for him.
- I have begun the **Watercolor Cowl** designed by Kaffe Fassett. Take advantage of our kit pricing and learn intersia in our Watercolor Cowl class.
