We are offering some interesting and fun classes this winter. We hope you can join us in our studio or online in our virtual classroom.

• XX-One Sweater by Hinterm Stein

This beautiful sweater is the most requested class at Nautical Yarn, so we decided to offer an in-person and virtual class this winter.

It is stylish and classy at the same time. Seamless, top-down and fun to knit, this cardigan features a well-fitting shoulder-construction and has many options for you to knit the perfectly fitting piece.

The XX-One pattern knits up quickly - no cabling, no annoying increasedecrease-pattern. 3 options for the body shaping and 2 options for the length give you the choice for a well-fitting cardigan. This project uses DK weight yarn and takes between 1185-1805 yds plus 145 yds for longer length. Sizes offered are XS-2XL.

• Carole will teach a *Learn to Knit Workshop* on Saturday, January 20 from 9 AM until noon. Learn to knit and purl and read a simple pattern. Bring worsted weight yarn and size 7, 8, or 9 needles.

• Michele will teach us how to make *Michele's Super Easy, Super Chunky Hat*, a knitted hat for beginners that uses BIG #6 (Super Bulky) yarn. This quick and easy project creates a cute, warm hat with a homemade pom pom using big yarn and needles. This class is offered Jan 23 & 30.

• Carole will teach a *Learn to Crochet Workshop* on Saturday, February 3 from 9 AM until noon. Learn single, double, and treble crochet. We'll learn to crochet back and forth and in the round. Bring worsted weight yarn and size G, H, or I hook.

• Michele will teach a beautiful design from Joji Locatelli called **The Way from Brighton Shawl.** This shawl requires approximately 600 yds of DK weight yarn and size 7 needles. Feb 6, 13, & 27.

• Carole will teach **Beginning Tunisian Crochet** on Saturday, February 17 from 9 until noon.

• **MESA**, a **Tunisian Crochet Hat** designed by Toni Lipsey, class will follow on Thursday, February 29 (our extra Leap Year Day). The Mesa Hat brings the color without all the fuss by using self-striping yarn. When paired with a neutral color, the overall finish looks way more complicated than the actual stitches are. This hat (and matching scarf) is easy to customize and perfect for those looking to expand on their Tunisian crochet skills.
