• Introduction to Needle Tatting with Molly Yoshikawa

Do you want to create something so gorgeous and lacey without much effort, that is also relaxing and repetitive? Tatting with yarn is just that, and more! Enter the magical world of needle tatting with Molly and let your imagination soar! The Sunset Skinny Scarf is a beginner friendly pattern that walks you step by step through the basic "Ring and Chain method" of needle tatting. It is worked in a worsted weight yarn of the color of your choice and a wood tatting needle. In this 3-hour workshop, you will learn the ring and chain method, the double-stitch, the picot, and how to join rings together using a picot join.

Materials needed: worsted weight yarn, scissors, stitch markers, tapestry needle **Instructor provides**: pattern, wood tatting needles for practice (\$3 if you want to purchase) **Cost**: \$35 includes class and lunch.
